CONTEXT: CONTEXT:

Europe's largest inhabited river island, divided into the districts Wilhelmsburg and Veddel

Number with people living on Elbe Islands with an immigrant background is 55% in Wilhelmsburg and 70% in Veddel, citywide average is only 29%.

Very young districts: 21.7% of the population is under 18, of which 73.3% have an immigrant background

23.8% is being supported by government help Hamburg average: 10.8%

Home to people from more than 130 nations, being more or less in separate and parallel communities.

Since 2007 the Elbe Islands are in the focus of fast city development
